SUBJECT: **PRESENTATION OF SAN DIEGO RIVER PARK
CONCEPTUAL PLAN**

Rob Hutsel (Executive Director, San Diego River Park Foundation) will present an overview of the San Diego River Park Conceptual Plan. The Board will discuss and consider accepting the Conceptual Plan. The Enabling Statute, Conceptual Plan, and the City of San Diego's Draft Master Plan may serve as the SDRC's initial planning and prioritizing efforts. *(Rob Hutsel)*

PURPOSE: Information item. The Board will consider accepting the Conceptual Plan.

DISCUSSION: The Conceptual Plan was developed in June 2002 for the San Diego River Park Foundation by the California State Polytechnic University, Pomona (Department of Landscape Architecture, 606 Studio).

Until the Conservancy has completed its formal Strategic Plan, I recommend that the Foundation's Conceptual Plan along with the Enabling Statute, City of San Diego's Draft Master Plan, and Santee's San Diego River Park Plan informally serve as the Conservancy's initial planning and prioritizing efforts. These documents will also serve as the foundation (i.e., starting point) for the Conservancy's formal Strategic Plan.
